MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING SUGAR CITY COUNCIL MONDAY, JULY 3, 2006

The Mayor expressed appreciation to the Council for their time and effort spent in their assignments.

DISCUSSION ON BIKE PATH/JEPPESEN EASEMENT: The Mayor explained Dick Dyer sent a memorandum dated June 28, 2006, on the bike path and pipeline easement. A discussion was had on the memorandum, and also the sewer line being on Jeppesens' property. The Mayor reported we received a letter from Tom Cole, who said any more delay in the bike path could cause them to withdraw the financing. The Council concluded that the Sun River sewer line being laid out of the easement was the lack of engineering supervision and mismanagement on the part of the contractor. The problem we face today with the easement for the bike path through Jeppesens 100 feet of property should have been solved before the application for funding of the bike path was sent in to the Idaho Transportation Department.
