## **NEW UTILITY PENALTY AND SERVICE FEES:**

City Council recently approved a resolution for delinquent utility notice procedures and utility penalty and service fees.

**Delinquent** bills not paid in full by the due date of the 25<sup>th</sup> will incur a **\$10.00 Late Fee**, utility bills are due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month, and delinquent after the 25<sup>th</sup>.

Services will be subject to disconnect on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month for delinquent accounts unless approved payment arrangements are made prior to the due date.

Disconnect Fee is \$20.00

Reconnect Fee is \$20.00

After hours reconnect fee is \$30.00 Paper Billing Statement Monthly Fee is \$1.00

**PLANNING & ZONING PUBLIC HEARING:** A hearing will be held March 16<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 pm at City Hall regarding the application for a Special Use Permit to allow the expansion of the existing Sugar RV Park.

**CITY COUCIL PUBLIC HEARING:** The City Council will hold a Public Hearing to speak about the transfer of the Business Park Lot to Madison County for the Coroner's office, Dispatch Center, and eventually Law Enforcement Office.

**OVERNIGHT PARKING:** Beginning March 1<sup>st</sup>, our snow ordinance will no longer be in effect. We have appreciated cooperation in not parking on the streets this winter. However, if there is snow in the forecast please remove your vehicles for the plows.

**SPRINKLER SYSTEMS:** <u>Backflow preventers</u> are required on all sprinkler systems. If you didn't have a test on your sprinkler system backflow preventer done last year, please have one done this year and return your report to City Hall or email it to <u>ajacobson@sugarcityidaho.gov</u>. This is necessary to ensure that contamination of the water supply will not happen in the event of a pressure loss to the water system. <u>Odd numbered addresses are to be tested this year</u> and even numbered addresses are to be tested in even numbered years. If you have an even numbered address and did not test last year, need to be tested this year also. Businesses are required to test every year. The deadline to have these completed is July 1<sup>st</sup> to avoid water services from being terminated. If you have an appointment to have your test done and it is after the 1<sup>st</sup> of July, please notify the city at <u>ajacobson@sugarcityidaho.gov</u> with the date it is scheduled and with whom. Thank you!

**DOG LICENSES:** Please come in and purchase a lifetime tag. Licenses are required. Licenses are \$15.00 per pet for their lifetime. If you have a photo of your pet to put on file this would also be helpful. To avoid fines, please license your pets, keep them on a leash and remove any waste they leave anywhere along your walk. See City Code **4-4-6 ANIMALS RUNNING AT LARGE:** It is unlawful for any animal or animals to run at large on any of the streets, alleys or public places within the city limits. Any owner or custodian of any animal, who allows the animal to run at large within Sugar City, is guilty of an infraction.
