**TENNIS COURTS:** The council discussed the following items concerning the tennis courts summarized below:

- Courts should all be in one location
- Maintenance best under school's responsibility instead of the city taking on two courts to lessen city liability
- Best to keep the grid system with North Park. North Fremont has potential traffic problems tying into the future north east/west road
- School road issue needs must be worked out before tennis agreement since ball fields may possibly be moved into a city road easement to accommodate the tennis courts
- Clarification that the \$3,000 per year is for scheduled maintenance and the 34% of cost for unscheduled repairs are fair and reasonable expenses in favor of the city
- Bonded contractors should be in the agreement

## CITY BUDGET:

- Concerns depleting certain budgeted items at beginning of fiscal year
- The cost of \$300,000 does not benefit all citizens
- A public hearing will need to held to open the budget and reallocate the funds
- ARPA funds cannot be used.

The council asked the City Attorney Chase Hendricks to draft a letter of intent listing conditions for the next council meeting to enable the school to move forward as the details are worked out.
