PLANNING AND ZONING PUBLIC HEARING: to be held on Nov. 21st at 7:00 pm regarding request for a Zone Change in Teton Island Estates Phase 2 from R1 to R2. Contact city hall for more information.

HOLIDAY CLOSURES: City Hall will be closed November 11th in observance of Veterans Day and the office will close at noon November 27th through November 29th in observance of Thanksgiving.

HOLIDAY GARBAGE PICK-UP: Garbage pickup will be on Saturday, November 30th, due to Thanksgiving.

**VETERANS DAY:** Take time to remember and thank veterans who have served to preserve freedom.

ANNUAL CHRISTMAS TREE LIGHTING: Mark your calendars! The Christmas Tree Lighting ceremony is Monday, December 2nd at Heritage Park at 6 p.m.

WATER METER READING: Your final meter read for the year happened the end of October. To keep your average utility bill for the winter lower, do not water any more until next April.

UTILITY RATE CHANGES: There is a Cost-of-Living Rate Increase to sewer, water and garbage. The changes will be on your November utility bill. The monthly water base fee will increase from \$43.48 to \$44.91; the monthly sewer base fee will increase from \$24.97 \$25.97. There is an increase of \$.04 from \$1.11 to \$1.15 per thousand gallons of water usage. There is an increase of \$0.13 from \$3.99 to \$4.12 per thousand gallons for sewer. A residential garbage can is increasing from \$17.61 to \$18.19 per month. A second can increases from \$13.22 to \$13.66.

SNOW REMOVAL & OVERNIGHT PARKING: Keep cars uncovered from snow and parked back from roads to eliminate being clipped by the snowplows. Reminder of our snow ordinance - no parking on city streets from December 1st through March 1st, between the hours of 12 midnight and 7 a.m. If there is a snow event before the first of December, please move your vehicles off the roads to allow the snowplows to do their jobs more efficiently.

KENNEL & DOG LICENSE REMINDER: Kennel licenses expire December 31st. The cost to renew is \$50. If you already have a lifetime Sugar City Dog license for your pets, please email sjones@sugarcityidaho.gov with an update on your dogs (names, etc.). If you no longer have pets that have been licensed, please let us know. If you have a pet that hasn't been licensed,

please come into city hall to obtain one. The cost is \$25 per pet lifetime. If you have a photo of

your pet to put on file it would be helpful if they are ever lost.

BUSINESS LICENSE REMINDER: Business licenses expire Dec 31st. Commercial licenses are \$50.00 and home business licenses are \$20.00. You may send in a check to pay for your license and a new license will be mailed to you. (Do not combine with utility payment; it must be a separate check.)
