The Mayor and City Council adapted **Resolution 210-6** on June 10, 2010, to regulate such use and for compensation to the city for such use. The Fire hydrant at the northwest corner of Moon Park on Railroad Avenue is designed as the water source for all commercial trucks. ANY HOOKUP MUST HAVE A FUNCTIONING BACK FLOW DEVICE.

FAILURE TO USE A BACK FLOW DEVICE WHEN HOOKING UP TO A FIRE HYDRANT SHALL SUBJECT THE USER TO AN ADDITIONAL \$500 FEE PER OCCURRENCE.
