### State of the Cities

Mayor Steve Adams spoke at Madison County's State of the Cities. His remarks are listed below:

The Business Park in town has had all the lots purchased and under development.

Sugar City has worked out an agreement with the people in the Salem area to include it in Sugar City's impact zone.

He said there are also people living in Salem who are now on the Planning and Zoning Committee.

He's also excited about the new tennis courts and ice-skating rink that are now available to people in the city.

The city's fiber optic network was also built out in 2024 to reach all of its residents. Lots of things are happening within Sugar City.

### UPDATES

Sugar City has a Sewer Increase of 0.25 per 1,000-gallon usage more per month. This will be reflected in the February bill.

Sugar City had a fantastic Public Works Employee; Cody Cureton, leave after 9 years of faithful service. We wish him well. We will have a new member of the department join us soon! We appreciate all the hard work the Public Works Department puts into the city.
