IMPORTANT TRASH SERVICE INFO

PSI has informed the city that many residents are overfilling their trash cans, which increases costs when people dispose of more than they're paying for. Trash cans should be filled only to the top, with the lid able to close completely. Trash should not stick up above the rim, be placed on top of the can, or be left outside the can in bags on the ground. If you need a second TRASH CAN, it is \$14 per month. You can start or stop service for an extra can anytime. If your trash can is reported more than once for overfilling, there will be an added fee to your utility bill.

NO SIDEWALK PARKING LIMITED TRAILER & RV PARKING

SIDEWALKS AND PARKING IN THE CITY:
SUGAR CITY CODE 5-2-6 PROHIBITED PARKING
States that no person shall park on a sidewalk area. This also includes sidewalk areas in front of driveways. No part of a car should be on the sidewalk. Other items making it difficult for wheelchair access should also be removed from sidewalks.
No person shall park an RV (TRAILER) on any street for more than 7 consecutive days and no more than 14 days cumulative total in any one calendar year. SCC 6-1-2 states trailers, containers, or non-vehicular items may not be parked on streets for more than 5 days.
